



- Borders and points of entry: early detection
- Inside districts
- ✓ Establishing Triage and Quarantine centers in all governorates
- ✓ Preventive Medicine focal person in each governorate
- ✓ Free line phone contact for the community

COVID-19 Diagnostic laboratories



Capacity building of lab technicians of CPHL



Provision of laboratory diagnostic materials for testing and detecting the virus



The Central Public Health Laboratory has been able to conduct tests and diagnose cases of COVID-19 since February 6, 2020.



Increase the capacity of the MoH laboratories to conduct the PCR examination: (we have now 7 operating MOH labs with total capacity of 7,000 tests/ day)



Recruiting additional staff, additional equipments, testing materials (testing kits and swaps)



WHO recommendations for testing: Rapid Antigen Test (in Emergency Rooms)

Isolation and Quarantine Policies



Quarantine centers established at the beginning of the pandemic.



Home Quarantine for close contacts (14 days)



Home isolation for mild & asymptomatic cases



Moderate and severe cases are admitted to specified treatment centers .

Hospital Preparedness

Hospitals Preparedness Plan for COVID

Special Treatment centers for covid-19 patients in large districts (7 specific centers)

General hospitals have dedicated some beds for COVID patients

Total COVID beds: 525

Increase the number of ICU units and ventilators for COVID-19 patients: 152 ventilators and 189 ICU beds.

All hospitals should be prepared for dealing with COVID patients

Technical instructions about surveillance system (home quarantine, protective measures, ...etc)

Continuous follow up and updates according to WHO, CDC...










COVID19 Daily Reported Cases – West Bank




COVID19 Daily Reported Cases - Gaza




Case Fatality Rate by Age - WB




Cases by Gender

Challenges faced during covid-19 Pandemic

✓ Israeli Occupation:

- Israeli control of borders and resources
- Restrictions on movement between districts
- Palestinian workers in Israel
- Limited access to East Jerusalem.
- Geographical separation between West bank and Gaza strip.
- √ Financial Crisis: withholding tax revenues by the Israeli side.
- ✓ Shortages in health workers (ICU, anesthesia, pulmonology ..)
- ✓ Overstretched hospital capacity before COVID pandemic.
- **✓** Community beliefs and resistance to the reality of the pandemic
